




Summer Internship Projects - Sector (in %) 2019 - 2021

Admission Procedure

Admission

DYPBS conducts online and offline selection processes covering the nook and corner of the country to provide last-mile connectivity to students, dispensing equal opportunities to all deserving candidates.

Our selection process covers a wide spectrum of attributes that include the candidate's academic performance and have equal weightage on student's co-curricular & extracurricular achievements.

Since inception, the institute has enjoyed substantial participation from different states & union territories that resulted in the evolution

Committees

Committees & College Mission

The achievement of the College Mission requires the implementation of parallel supportive programs. Such implementation is possible through the various committees which act as a means of streamlining college administration. The objectives, functions, roles and responsibilities of the committees are formulated and evaluated keeping in mind the College Mission as a guiding principle.

Committees constituted to streamline college administration are a potent means for implementing supportive action programmers directed towards achieving the College Mission. This College Mission will act as the benchmark for setting as well as evaluating the objectives, goals and targets of the committees.

The following types of committees are appointed in D. Y. Patil B-School:

- a. Statutory Committees: These committees are constituted as per the provisions of AICTE. The tenure and composition of these committees are determined by the GB in accordance with AICTE rules.
- b. Non-Statutory Committees: These committees are appointed by the Director to facilitate the efficient and decentralized functioning of the college administration. The non-teaching staff members of these committees are appointed by the Registrar in consultation with appropriate authorities. The functions of these members are largely administrative.
- **c. Ad-hoc Committees:** These committees are constituted only temporarily for executing contingency duties.

College Development Committee

This committee reporting to the Governing Body is responsible for preparing an overall comprehensive development plan of the college regarding academic, administrative, and infrastructural growth, and enabling the Institute to foster excellence in curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)

IQAC has been constituted under the Chairmanship of the Head of the institution with heads of important academic and administrative units and a few teachers and a few distinguished educationists and representatives of local management and stakeholders. The objectives of the IQAC are to develop a system for conscious, consistent, and catalytic action to improve the academic and administrative performance of the institution as well as to promote measures for institutional functioning towards quality enhancement through internalization of quality culture and institutionalization of best practices.

Academic Advisory Board

Academic Advisory Board at DYPBS is formed to contribute towards taking inputs from various academicians in different roles to suggest best practices at the strategic & operational level in the business school. Members of DYPBS Academic Advisory Board assist in enhancing curriculum and provide counsel on strategic and operational directions to be followed to achieve institutional vision and desired outcomes.

Academic Committee

The Academic Committee is the most constitutive fragment of the Institute, working in unison with the Board of Directors, Governing Council and IQAC. It is accountable for spurring the intellectual ecosystem in the Institute for its seamless functions. It is responsible for ministering the curriculum, semester planning, academic calendar, examination dates, personal development of the students and the entire academic process and procedures.

Admission Committee

For the purpose of achieving the precepts of admission policy, the Admission Committee is constituted for conduct of fair and transparent admission process as mandated by AICTE, New Delhi which takes into consideration diversity in admission and effective competency in candidates. Admission Committee at Dr.D.Y.Patil B-School will ensure overall smooth functioning of PGDM admission process and ensure all adherence of AICTE rules and regulations related to PGDM admissions. It will be the endeavor of



the Admission Committee to complete required documentation and PGDM admission process is implemented as per set policy.

Alumni Committee

The Alumni Relations Committee of Dr. D.Y. Patil B-School is a body instituted to foster and strengthen the bond between the Alumni, the institute and present students at the institute. The alumni of the institute embark their corporate journey once placed from the institute. They perform well in their organization with flying colors, or they join new organizations with new roles, or some even start their own ventures and become entrepreneurs. The purpose of the committee is to invite these alumni's back to the campus so that they can share remarkable journey with the current students and add value to their lives.

Anti-Ragging Committee

The Anti-Ragging Committee constituted on 20th July, 2017 functions as per the provisions of Anti-Ragging Act in and outside the college campus. (Anti-Ragging, Act 2009). The purpose of this committee is to create awareness about the detrimental effects of ragging and take swift action against any such incident in the institute which amounts to ragging.

Corporate Advisory Board

Corporate Advisory Board is an external body of corporate members to help the institute for gathering insights and to solicit advice to solve business issues or to explore new opportunities by meeting with corporates every time during the academic year. The members of the Corporate Advisory Board provide non-binding strategic advices to the institution management for the betterment of the institution. The members are from renowned corporate industries, which help to enhance the percentage of final placements of the students and the percentage of summer internship programs also. The expert lectures from the corporates improves the employability percentage and help the students to gain the practical knowledge from the industry.

Discipline Committee

The Discipline Committee is entrusted with the task of ensuring compliance of the Code of Conduct by students and employees of Dr.D.Y.Patil B-School, Tathawade. The aim of such a code is to administer an egalitarian discipline process and promote student growth through individual and collective responsibility.

The Committee has jurisdiction over the conduct of the students associated /enrolled with the Institute. It will take into cognizance all acts of misconduct which take place on the Institute campus or in connection with the Institute related activities and functions. The Committee may also exercise jurisdiction over conduct which occurs off-campus and is found to violate the code in case such conduct has repercussions on the Institute's interests or reputation.

Internal Complaints Committee

As per Section 4, All India Council for Technical Education (Gender Sensitization, Prevention and Prohibition of Sexual Harassment of Women Employees and Students and Redressal of Grievances in Technical Institutions) Regulations, 2016 vide No. F. AICTE/WH/2016/ 01 dated 10th June, 2016, an Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) has been established with effect from 01/08/2018. The Internal Complaints Committee (ICC), consisting of four members from the employees, one from students' body. and one NGO member is constituted to look into any complaint related to harassment based on gender. The Internal Complaints Committee (Anti-Sexual Harassment) will meet immediately on the receipt of a complaint and at least twice a year even if there is no formal complaint lodged.

SC & ST Committee

For protection against harassment and discrimination of Scheduled Castes in AICTE Approved Institutions, it is essential for all AICTE approved institutions to establish Committee for SC/ ST (As per the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, No. 33 of 1989, dated 11.09.1989). The SC/ST/OBC/PWD students can approach any of the members including the Chairman of the Cell for redressal of any grievance(s) regarding academic, administrative or social problems. The Section Officer/Liaison Officer will meet the concerned students, understand their problems and take necessary actions and/or render them necessary advice/help to resolve the matter.

Student Grievance Redressal Committee

In order to provide opportunities for redressal of certain grievances of students already enrolled

in any institution, as well as for those seeking admission to such institutions, AICTE has



notified All India Council for Technical Education (Redressal of Grievance of Students) Regulations, 2019 vide F. FDP Committee



and smiles on everyone's faces.


